The Great 50 Days - Pastor Sorenson

Alleluia! Christ is risen! What a great joy it was to celebrate the resurrection of our Lord with you last month. Easter is always such a joyous time of year as the victory of Christ over sin, death, and the devil is laid before us. This joy is even greater when you consider the season of Lent and the services of Holy Week which were preparing us for Easter morning. Yet, Lent and Holy Week were not just preparing us for Easter morning. They were also preparing us for the entire season of Easter, which is commonly referred to as the Great 50 Days.


To be sure, you will not see or hear this in the world. The stores will have long ago put away all of their Easter decorations. There will be no Easter egg hunts after Easter Sunday. Memorial Day sales will begin as soon as the Easter signs are taken down. This should not surprise you. The world is always quick to celebrate for a single day, but it does not want you to dwell on the that celebration any longer than that.

This is why it is so important to understand the seasons of the Church year. For Easter did not end on Easter Sunday. It was just beginning. From Easter Sunday until Pentecost Sunday, the Church will continue to consider and celebrate the resurrection of Christ. Our readings will reflect this, as we hear of the various events which occurred following our Lord's resurrection. Our hymns will reflect this, as we sing of Christ's victory again and again. Our paraments will reflect this, as the color for the next 50 days will be white, reminding your eyes of Easter morning.

The length of this season is no accident either. For, after His resurrection, Christ walked this earth for 40 days. Then, on the 40<sup>th</sup> day after His resurrection, He ascended into heaven. This year, Ascension Day falls on May 30<sup>th</sup>, which is 40 days after April 21<sup>st</sup>. The final 10 days of this great 50 day season of Easter are those days following the Lord's ascension until His promise of sending the Holy Spirit is accomplished on the day of Pentecost. In this way, the Church rightly celebrates all of the events of Christ's resurrection even as the apostles would have experienced them over those 50 days.

This may just seem like a nice touch on the Church calendar. This may seem like it means something to theologians, but not to ordinary people, but this should most certainly not be the case. Instead, let the Church year, and in particular this Great 50 Days, start to change and mold your mind away from the ways of the world and into the ways of Christ.

For the effects of Christ's resurrection are not to be confined to a single day, as the world will try to teach you, but rather they are to be lived out every day of your life. For the next 50 days, you, as a member of the Church, will have a chance to experience this. You will see how Christ's resurrection shapes everything we think, say, and do. You will see how Christ's resurrection is not just His victory, but your victory. You will see how 50 short days can truly be great, if, indeed, they are joined to Christ's resurrection. For He is risen indeed! Alleluia!
