
St. Peter Evangelical Lutheran Church Funeral Service for Donna Thomas - July 23, 2020 Pastor Erik Sorenson



Christian Obituary for Donna Thomas:

Donna Thomas was given life by her Creator and was born on September 24, 1934, the child of Irwin and Minnie Moorman. 


