





Introit


Psalm 147:1, 5, 11–12; antiphon: John 1:14










Salutation and Collect of the Day



And I believe in one holy Christian and apostolic Church,


I acknowledge one Baptism for the remission of sins,

and I look for the resurrection of the dead






5 The veil is torn, our Priest we see, As at the rail on bended knee Our hungry mouths from Him receive The bread of immortality.





A Let us pray.




