when you open your hand, they are filled with good things.


When you send forth your Spirit, they are created,





C I believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth.





Each week between now and our 150th anniversary celebration, the bulletin and/or announcements will include excerpts from some of our Church's early board meeting minutes.

Below are some excerpts from Board Minutes from April 2, 1871 to October 6, 1912. These were written in German and translated by Rev. A. A. Mueller. It is worth noting how important church attendance and voter meeting attendance was and that being in church and living a life according to God's Word was extremely important. Christian life was to be lived every day.

November 29, 1874: Since Mr. S--- has shown himself to be an obstinate sinner with respect to his drunkenness, the congregation resolved to excommunicate him from the congregation until he shows improvement. May God grant that he will do so before he dies in his sins.

Below you will find a model you can use for your personal or family devotions that focuses you on the readings from the previous Sunday, while also preparing you for what you will hear the following Sunday. Amen. <u>Read the Epistle lesson</u> : Acts 2:1-21 – On the Day of Pentecost, the Lord poured out the Spirit so the proclamation of Christ may go out into all the world and everyone who hears Christ and calls on His name may be saved. <u>Sing the Hymn of the Day</u> : LSB 497 – Come, Holy Ghost, God and Lord <u>Pray the Collect of the Day</u> : (see 5/24)			
Wed. 5/26:	<u>Read the Gospel lesson</u> : John 15:26-27; 16:4b-15 – The Holy Spirit comes to us to bear witness to Christ and the truth of His Word. This is always the work of the Spirit: to guide us to Christ. <u>Sing the Hymn of the Day</u> : LSB 497 – Come, Holy Ghost, God and Lord <u>Pray the Collect of the Day</u> : (see 5/24)			
Thur. 5/27:	 <u>Read the Old Testament lesson</u>: Isaiah 6:1-8 – The seraphim in heaven proclaim the truth and majesty of the Holy Trinity when they proclaim, "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts." <u>Sing the Hymn of the Day</u>: LSB 498 – Come, Holy Ghost, Creator Blest <u>Pray the Collect of the Day</u>: Almighty and everlasting God, You have given us grace to acknowledge the glory of the eternal Trinity by the confession of a true faith and to worship the Unity in the power of the Divine Majesty. Keep us steadfast in this faith and defend us from all adversities; for You, O Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, live and reign, one God, now and forever. Amen. 			
Fri. 5/28:	<u>Read the Epistle lesson</u> : Acts 2:14a, 22-36 – Having received the Holy Spirit from the Father, Peter confesses the death and resurrection of Jesus who is both Christ and Lord. <u>Sing the Hymn of the Day</u> : LSB 498 – Come, Holy Ghost, Creator Blest <u>Pray the Collect of the Day</u> : (see 5/27)
