





- Mon. 7/12: Read the Old Testament lesson: Amos 7:7-15 Amos, like all of the servants of God, was sent by God to proclaim God's Word, not his own. Even when it was hard to hear, Amos remained faithful, speaking what God had given him to speak. Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 743 Jesus, Priceless Treasure Pray the Collect of the Day: O Lord, You granted Your prophets strength to resist the temptations of the devil and courage to proclaim repentance. Give us pure hearts and minds to follow You Son faithfully even into suffering and death; through the same Jesus Christ, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

 Read the Epistle lesson: Ephesians 1:3-14 Before the foundation of the world, we were chosen to receive the inheritance of Christ, which God lavishes upon us through the work of the Holy Spirit.
