In modeling your devotions this way, you and your family can stay united to the church year and reinforce what you hear, sing, and pray every Sunday.

Mon. 7/26: Read the Old Testament lesson: Genesis 9:8-17 - The rainbow reminds us and God that He will never again destroy the earth with a flood because He has made a covenant with us to save us and give us life. Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 754 – Entrust Your Days and Burdens Pray the Collect of the Day: Almighty and most merciful God, the protector of all who trust in You, strengthen our faith and give us courage to believe that in Your love You will rescue us from all adversities; through Jesus Christ, Your Son, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen. Tues. 7/27: Read the Epistle lesson: Ephesians 3:14-21 – The Father strengthens us through the Spirit so that Christ may dwell in us through faith with the fullness of His saving love. Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 754 – Entrust Your Days and Burdens Pray the Collect of the Day: (see 7/26) Wed. 7/28: Read the Gospel lesson: Mark 6:45-56 – Even though our hearts are sometimes hardened so we do not understand Christ rightly, still He comes to us and shows us we have nothing to fear because He is the Lord of all creation. Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 754 – Entrust Your Days and Burdens Pray the Collect of the Day: (see 7/26) Thur. 7/29: Read the Old Testament lesson: Exodus 16:2-15 – Even though the people grumbled against the Lord. He provided bread for them to eat so they may know that He is the Lord their God. Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 918 – Guide Me, O Thou Great Redeemer Pray the Collect of the Day: Merciful Father, You gave Your Son Jesus as the heavenly bread of life. Grant us faith to feast on Him in Your Word and Sacraments that we may be nourished unto life everlasting: through the same Jesus Christ, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen. Fri. 7/30: Read the Epistle lesson: Ephesians 4:1-16 – Let us, by the grace of God, grow up in maturity in Christ, ever learning His Word and doctrine. For God has called us to this very thing. Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 918 – Guide Me, O Thou Great Redeemer Pray the Collect of the Day: (see 7/29) Sat. 7/31: Read the Gospel lesson: John 6:22-35 – Jesus is the Bread of Life that the Father gives us so that we may know Him, believe in Him, and have eternal life. Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 918 – Guide Me, O Thou Great Redeemer Pray the Collect of the Day: (see 7/29)
