#### **Dust Off Your Catechism**

Youth Catechesis classes begin again on August 21<sup>st</sup> this year. This is an exciting time for our youth who will either begin or continue learning more about the faith in this class. They will, of course, be instructed in the whole counsel of God as He reveals it in Holy Scripture and they will also be using the helpful tool of Martin Luther's Small Catechism to accomplish this goal.

The Small Catechism has been used ever since the days of the Reformation, not because it was written by Martin Luther, but because it is a faithful, thorough, and simple explanation of the Christian faith.

That's really the point of the Catechism. It presents the basics of the faith in an easy-to-understand manner, while simultaneously opening the door to the full depth of God's Word. In this way, the Catechism is perfect for Christians of any age. The youngest Christian can hear and learn the words of the Catechism just as much as the oldest Christian can dive back in to discover more of God's riches.

Our youth will immerse themselves in this Catechism for the next several months, soaking up everything it teaches about God and His grace and mercy towards us. They will recite it together, memorize it together, discuss it together, and rejoice in it together as Christ is always front and center.

But this doesn't have to be the case only for those Christians in 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Let this be a loving encouragement to us all to dust off our Catechisms to read and learn. There's always more we can learn about the faith and the Catechism is a great way to do just that.

It doesn't have to be anything fancy or intense. Simply read a small portion of it each morning or night. Or focus on a section each week or each month. Read it aloud as a family and perhaps look up Bible passages that speak to whatever section you study. Try memorizing a part of it, even when there's no assignment to do so!

That's the great thing about the Catechism. Every Christian can use it and learn from it in a variety of ways. Whether you use it daily, weekly, monthly, or anything else, continuing to read or hear the Catechism is a fantastic way to grow in the faith.

No matter how long ago Catechesis was for you, then, or no matter how far into the future it may be for your children or grandchildren, dust off your Catechism. Let the simple way that Luther teaches the basics of the faith be in your heart and mind. Let the faith which God Himself has created in you be nurtured as you use this helpful tool in addition to reading and hearing the Word of God.

And as you do, remember to keep our catechumens in your prayers and encourage them as they learn from the very same Catechism. Pray that God may continue to bring them growth in the faith which He first planted in them in Holy Baptism. Pray that God may bring them to a deeper knowledge of His truth. Pray that God may give them joy in their identity as His beloved children. Because, as the Catechism says, that's who we are all in and through Christ Jesus, our Lord.





He does all this out of pure, fatherly, divine goodness and mercy, without any merit or worthiness in me. For all this I ought to thank Him, praise Him, serve Him, and obey Him.
