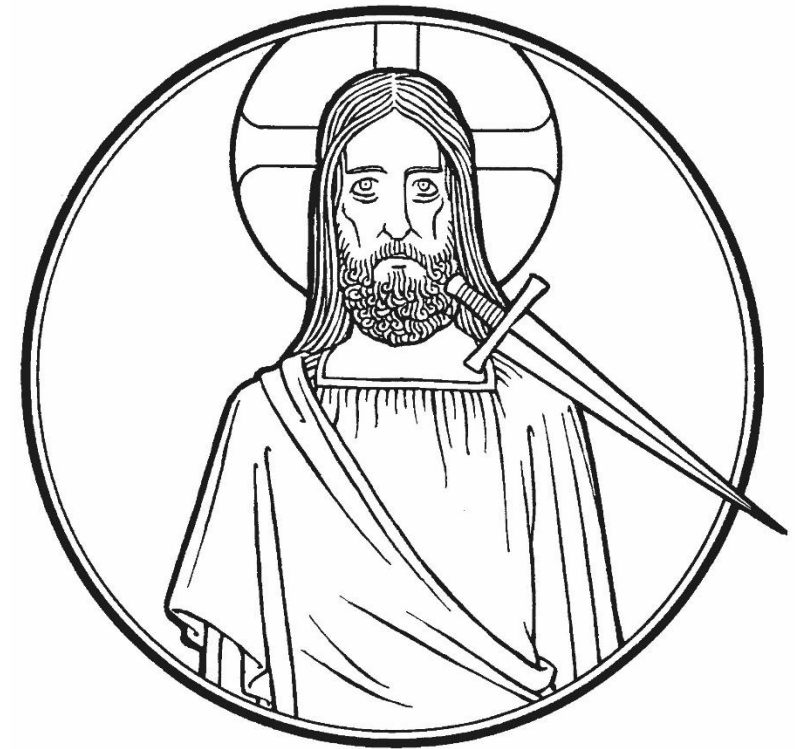
Below you will find a model you can use for your personal or family devotions that focuses you on the readings from the previous Sunday, while also preparing you for what you will hear the following Sunday. In modeling your devotions this way, you and your family can stay united to the church year and reinforce what you hear, sing, and pray every Sunday.

- Mon. 6/29: Read the Old Testament lesson: Jeremiah 28:5-9 – The true prophets sent by the Lord proclaim the peace which God has come to bring His people.
Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 685 – Let Us Ever Walk with Jesus
Pray the Collect of the Day: Almighty God, by the working of Your Holy Spirit, grant that we may gladly hear Your Word proclaimed among us and follow its directing; through Jesus Christ, Your Son, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.
- Tues. 6/30: Read the Epistle lesson: Romans 7:1-13 – We are released from the effects of the Law because we have died with Christ and been raised with Him to new life.
Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 685 – Let Us Ever Walk with Jesus
Pray the Collect of the Day: (6/29)
- Wed. 7/1: Read the Gospel lesson: Matthew 10:34-42 – Christ comes to bring a sword to this world, dividing those who believe in Him from those who do not. Though the believers lose their life for the sake of Christ, they also receive the reward of Christ which is eternal life.
Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 685 – Let Us Ever Walk with Jesus
Pray the Collect of the Day: (see 6/29)
- Thur. 7/2: Read the Old Testament lesson: Zechariah 9:9-12 – Your King is coming to you to destroy the might of your enemies and set you free by His blood.
Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 699 – I Heard the Voice of Jesus Say
Pray the Collect of the Day: Gracious God, our heavenly Father, Your mercy attends us all our days. Be our strength and support amid the wearisome changes of this world, and at life's end grant us Your promised rest and the full joys of Your salvation; through Jesus Christ, Your Son, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.
- Fri. 7/3: Read the Epistle lesson: Romans 7:14-25a – Stuck in our body of death, we do what we do not want and do not do what we should. Thanks be to God that Christ has delivered us from this body of death.
Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 699 – I Heard the Voice of Jesus Say
Pray the Collect of the Day: (see 7/2)
- Sat. 7/4: Read the Gospel lesson: Matthew 11:25-30 – Christ reveals to us, His little children who are burdened by sin, that He is our rest.
