

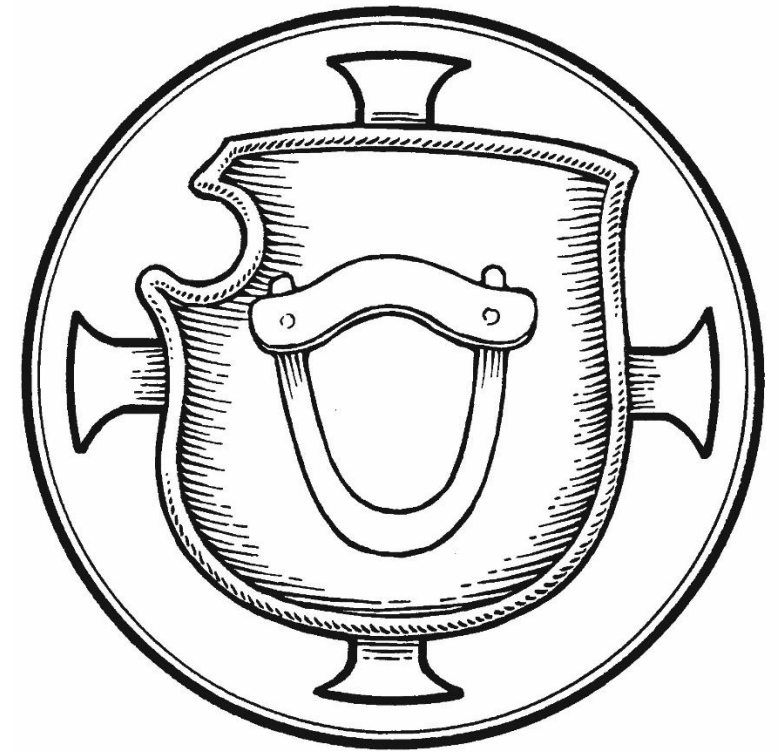
Before You, Lord, We Bow

Below you will find a model you can use for your personal or family devotions that focuses you on the readings from the previous Sunday, while also preparing you for what you will hear the following Sunday. In modeling your devotions this way, you and your family can stay united to the church year and reinforce what you hear, sing, and pray every Sunday.

- Mon. 7/6: Read the Old Testament lesson: Zechariah 9:9-12 – Your King is coming to you to destroy the might of your enemies and set you free by His blood.
Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 699 – I Heard the Voice of Jesus Say
Pray the Collect of the Day: Gracious God, our heavenly Father, Your mercy attends us all our days. Be our strength and support amid the wearisome changes of this world, and at life's end grant us Your promised rest and the full joys of Your salvation; through Jesus Christ, Your Son, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.
- Tues. 7/7: Read the Epistle lesson: Romans 7:14-25a – Stuck in our body of death, we do what we do not want and do not do what we should. Thanks be to God that Christ has delivered us from this body of death.
Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 699 – I Heard the Voice of Jesus Say
Pray the Collect of the Day: (see 7/6)
- Wed. 7/8: Read the Gospel lesson: Matthew 11:25-30 – Christ reveals to us, His little children who are burdened by sin, that He is our rest.

Pray the Collect of the Day: (see 7/6)
- Thur. 7/9: Read the Old Testament lesson: Isaiah 55:10-13 – The Word of God does not return empty, but like a seed that is sown, it grows and bears fruit.
Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 577 – Almighty God, Your Word Is Cast
Pray the Collect of the Day: Blessed Lord, since You have caused all Holy Scriptures to be written for our learning, grant that we may so hear them, read, mark, learn, and inwardly digest them that we may embrace and ever hold fast the blessed hope of everlasting life; through Jesus Christ, Your Son, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.
- Fri. 7/10: Read the Epistle lesson: Romans 8:12-17 – Through the Spirit, we are adopted as sons of God and thus we are heirs with Christ of eternal life.
Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 577 – Almighty God, Your Word Is Cast
Pray the Collect of the Day: (see 7/9)
- Sat. 7/11: Read the Gospel lesson: Matthew 13:1-9, 18-23 – Christ, the Sower, sows the seed of the Word abundantly among us and it bears the fruit of faith in Him.
Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 577 – Almighty God, Your Word Is Cast
Pray the Collect of the Day: (see 7/9)
